3	LAKE KIVU ↓ KIGALI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Relax and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of the calm and pristine waters of Africa's highest lake. The terrace of the hotel has fantastic views over Lake Kivu and its ragged shore. Optional excursions / activities are available (payable locally).</li> <li>▪ Drive back to Kigali. **Gorilla Permits**

In order to protect the gorillas the Rwandan government issues Gorilla Permits – ensuring that a limited number of tourists can track them each day. These permits are in high demand, so do book early to secure your chosen date/s.

**Please note:**

Tracking gorillas in Rwanda can be testing and requires a moderate to good level of fitness (though it is deemed easier than from Uganda where the trails are steeper and less accessible).

Treks are often 2 to 3 hours each way (but can be more) and involve hiking through dense forest and traversing steep ravines and mountainsides, often in damp conditions.

However, all this adventure is worthwhile for a glimpse of one of nature's finest spectacles.

There is a minimum age of 15 years on gorilla treks.

**What to wear and take on your gorilla trek:**

With changeable weather conditions and dense forest vegetation it is advisable to take layers of protective clothing. We recommend wearing the following:

- t-shirt
- long-sleeved top
- warm fleece / jumper
- thick trousers
- thick wool socks (and gaiters preferably)
- strong lightweight, water-proof walking boots
- hat with brim
- garden gloves to aid scrambling up banks

**And carry a small rucksack with:**

- water
- packed lunch and snacks
- binoculars
- camera / video camera with spare battery, memory cards or film
- light-weight rain mac / poncho
