1	KAMPALA ↓ QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drive towards western Uganda. Stop over at the local drum industry, the Equator, Masaka, and Mbarara for lunch. Drive through volcanic formations of the Western Rift Valley towards Queen Elizabeth national park. The descent reveals an astounding panorama of lakes George and Edward amidst game-filled plains. Dinner and overnight at Mweya Safari Lodge 	
2	QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Game drive, Chimpanzee Primates Trekking and a Boat Trip Queen Elizabeth National Park's diverse Eco-system of grassy plains, tropical forest, river, swamps, lakes and volcanic craters is home to an incredible abundance of wildlife. A game drive in this park, with massive Ruwenzoris as a backdrop provides excellent opportunities to see lion, leopard, giant forest hog, Cape buffalo, elephants, Uganda Kob, Topi and Bush buck. After game drive and lunch, take a boat trip on the Kazinga Channel. Dinner and overnight at Mweya Safari Lodge/ Jacana Safari Lodge/ Institute of Ecology. 	
3	KIBALE FOREST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> After breakfast, depart for Kibale Forest to track a variety of primate species. Kibale National Park runs contiguous with the northern end of Queen Elizabeth, but Kibale is much wetter with unique moist forest habitat and an extremely high diversity of animals and plants. Primates located here include Red colobus monkey, Mangabey, Olive baboons, and several communities of chimpanzee. Dinner and overnight at Ndali Lodge.
